This department is also responsible for the practice and education of dental anesthesiology, as well as the management and ensuring medical safety of the operating room in The University of Osaka Dental Hospital in cooperation with The University of Osaka Hospital. We are looking for candidates who will demonstrate originality, excellence, and outstanding research and clinical achievements from a broader perspective in these areas, and who will engage in teaching with great insight and passion.
