

Faculty Position in The University of Osaka Dental Hospital

Outline	<p>We had sought candidates for the position of Professor in the Division for Oral Dental Informatics, The University of Osaka Dental Hospital. We hereby announce that the application period has been extended.</p> <p>The professor of the division will be responsible for promoting advanced research in medical informatics in the field of dentistry and for operation and maintenance of electronic medical record systems, playing a major role in the digital transformation of our hospital. In particular, the professor is expected to integrate and manage various types of clinical data collected across departments in the hospital, developing next-generation medical information systems for their research utilization. The successful candidate will also be involved in education in related fields at both the Graduate School of Dentistry and the School of Dentistry.</p> <p>Furthermore, while working in close partnership with the Graduate School of Dentistry, the professor will handle medical information from an information science perspective and strive to establish a new foundation for dental clinical information through collaboration with medical institutions and information-related research organizations both within and outside the university. By promoting the digitalization of clinical information and the utilization of big data analytics, the professor is expected to contribute to the advancement of dental clinical practice.</p> <p>We are therefore seeking candidates who, in this field, demonstrate originality and outstanding research capabilities, possess an excellent record of scholarly achievements, and are willing to contribute to hospital management—including the development of medical information systems—and to education in related disciplines with deep insight and enthusiasm.</p>
